Conference Structure for 2019

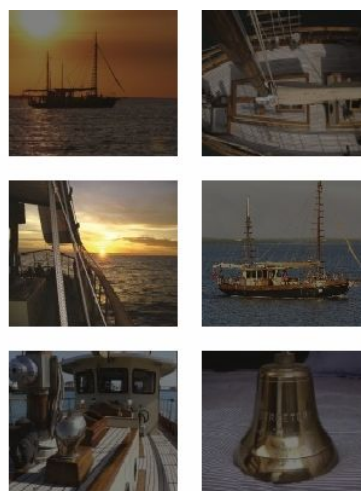
